News is where you write only about what, why, where, how and when it happened. Whereas, to make it a special story you need to get deeper into it. It means you will write about the humanitarian angle if any, you will explain in detail the reason for, say holding a jatara or a festival. How does your community celebrate a festival? Suppose a student tops the exams, how does it reflect on all of you? There was an accident. Describe it from the affected family angle like if the victim is the sole breadwinner how does it affect their life etc. Then there are issues like drinking water shortage, nonavailability of fertilizers or even an unfulfilled development work promise. Detail them. Use engaging language, storytelling techniques, and data or past examples to make it interesting. Always quote people.

#### 18. How do I edit content?

If you're skilled in content editing, you can join our Politikos Volunteers by signing up through our website or App. As a volunteer, you'll be tasked with editing stories to make them more engaging and impactful for our readers. There will be a tight schedule for this and time is essential for completing the assignment. #### **Feedback Mechanisms:**

Feedback from its Volunteers is very crucial for reviewing the performance and to improve efficiency of Politikos. Three major aspects of assessment will be directionality, frequency and urgency or response time.

- Good directionality implies being specific and explicit.
- As a rule of thumb more frequent directionally correct even if incomplete feedback has the capacity to outperform a more detailed but less frequent feedback. This means that consistency and iteration are what make proper feedback.
- Sooner than later is the cardinal principle of the feedback, a feedback doesn't begin at the end it has to be from a point where you progress say 25% or so in your works itself. This will eliminate wrong convergence of interests and wrong treading of the path in pursuit of the goals.
